- Thanks for praying for us during our three weeks of travels, saying goodbye to family. We know the trip was a success because Thomas now knows and asks about “his version” of the names of our immediate family members.
- All of the details necessary for our departure have come together in such amazing ways. We feel overwhelming confirmation from the Lord that we are following Him.

ITEMS FOR PRAYER –

- The evening of Monday, December 6, we leave Chicago for Brussels. After a brief layover in Brussels, we fly directly to Kigali, Rwanda. We should arrive in the late evening (mid-day in Chicago) on Tuesday. Please pray as the Lord directs you. Please remember our children, our health, and our luggage.
- Please continue to pray for God to lead us to the right language helpers. Again, these individuals will be instrumental in helping us learn Kinyarwanda – the prerequisite step to our involvement with New Creation Ministries.

- Tension is mounting between the Democratic Republic of the Congo and Rwanda. The threat is military conflict in Eastern Congo, bordering Rwanda.
