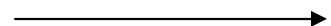

Pray specifically for good times of prayer, building of relationships among MNC's leadership, and a true sense of ownership of the ministry among the leaders.

HEALTH: Please pray for our family's health. The fluctuation in weather combined with busy schedules over the last few weeks has brought quite a few health struggles. Tim spent two weeks in January sick with strep throat. All three children are fighting off colds. And, Jessica is currently wrestling with a case of something.

NEIGHBORHOOD GIRL: Please continue to pray for the difficult situation with the family in our neighborhood. The father has literally lost his mind. The mother has problems with alcohol (but denies it). And, the oldest daughter (fifteen years) is pregnant. This family has had a close relationship with our mission for many years. Now we are finding it difficult to know how to help them in a constructive way. Please pray for wisdom for our team.
