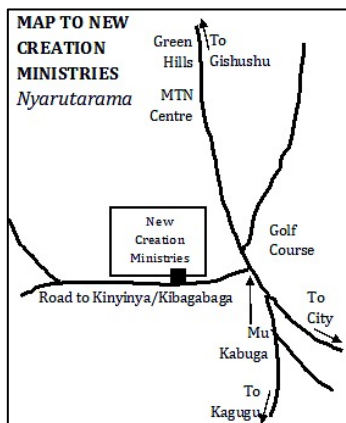

2. Reputation of Christian ministry
3. Calling to Christian leadership
4. Existing ministry responsibilities
5. Secondary school diploma or its equivalent
6. English language competence

## Application Steps

1. Go to [www.ncmrwanda.org/CLIR](http://www.ncmrwanda.org/CLIR)
2. Download & complete admission application
3. Submit records, references & other materials
4. Pass CLIR's English language proficiency test
5. Interview with CLIR's admissions committee
6. Submit payment for classes upon acceptance

## Registration Guidelines

CLIR uses a rolling admission process. Admission into CLIR does not guarantee a seat in class. Accepted students will be permitted to enroll in a course until the course reaches its maximum capacity. As a result prospective students are encouraged to apply and register early. Students may take 10 courses per year.

## *The Purpose of CLIR is...*

To provide transformational, discipleship-based education that will train Christian leaders to think clearly about Scripture, be grounded in their Christian faith and be able to fulfill the call upon their lives.

## Frequently Asked Questions

### **How does a student progress through CLIR's program? How long does it take?**

Progression through CLIR's program is based on accumulation of credits. After successful completion of each course, a student is awarded three credits. Grades for all courses are used to compute a student's grade point average (GPA), by which a student may know his/her academic standing. Students are free to study based on their availability. However, completion of the program is based on accumulation of credits, not years. A full-time student who intends to finish in three years will study 30 credits (10 courses) per year.

### **Should I study full- or part-time?**

Our program is intentionally structured so that you can study at the pace that is appropriate for you in light of your other responsibilities. Full-time means four nights per week for 40 weeks of the year. That is a big commitment, especially if you have a family and work. However, beginning to study slowly is better than never beginning at all.

### **Is CLIR accredited?**

While CLIR offers a significant educational experience, we are not accredited in Rwanda. Those who desire an accredited degree may complete three years (90 credits) at CLIR, then apply for a fourth year at one of two accredited partner schools. We are pursuing options for accreditation and are working with REB to ensure compliance with the theological education laws.
